### About the session:

The aim of the session is to provide all those involved in human research a thorough understanding of the values and principles of ethical conduct that applies to all human research with a focus on the protection of the research participant and their data.

The topics covered will include:

- Values and principles of ethical conduct
- Risks and benefits
- Consent and waiving consent
- Specific issues relating to research methods and participant groups
- The application and review process at Monash
- How to complete and navigate the application process
- Examples of concerns raised by the Human Research Ethics Committee

After completing the session the researcher will have a better understanding of the ethic issues that must be considered when planning research activities involving human participants and therefore improve the quality of the research and the ethics application with the probable outcome of reducing the time to obtain HREC clearances.
