Project Description:

Communication between relationship partners plays an important role in individual well-being and intimate relationship functioning. Since the introduction of the internet, communication patterns have evolved significantly. In the past years, however, a small but growing literature addresses questions related to the role of online communication, social platforms for relationship formation, and social media more generally, within intimate relationships. While most of these studies target general questions regarding the participation or use of these media and tools, the current research considers the use of these media and tools along with more traditional ways of exchange and contact in daily life. The project is a cooperation between the University of Fribourg (CH), Wayne State University (Detroit, US), University La Sapienza, Rome (I), and Monash University Kuala Lumpur (Malaysia).
