

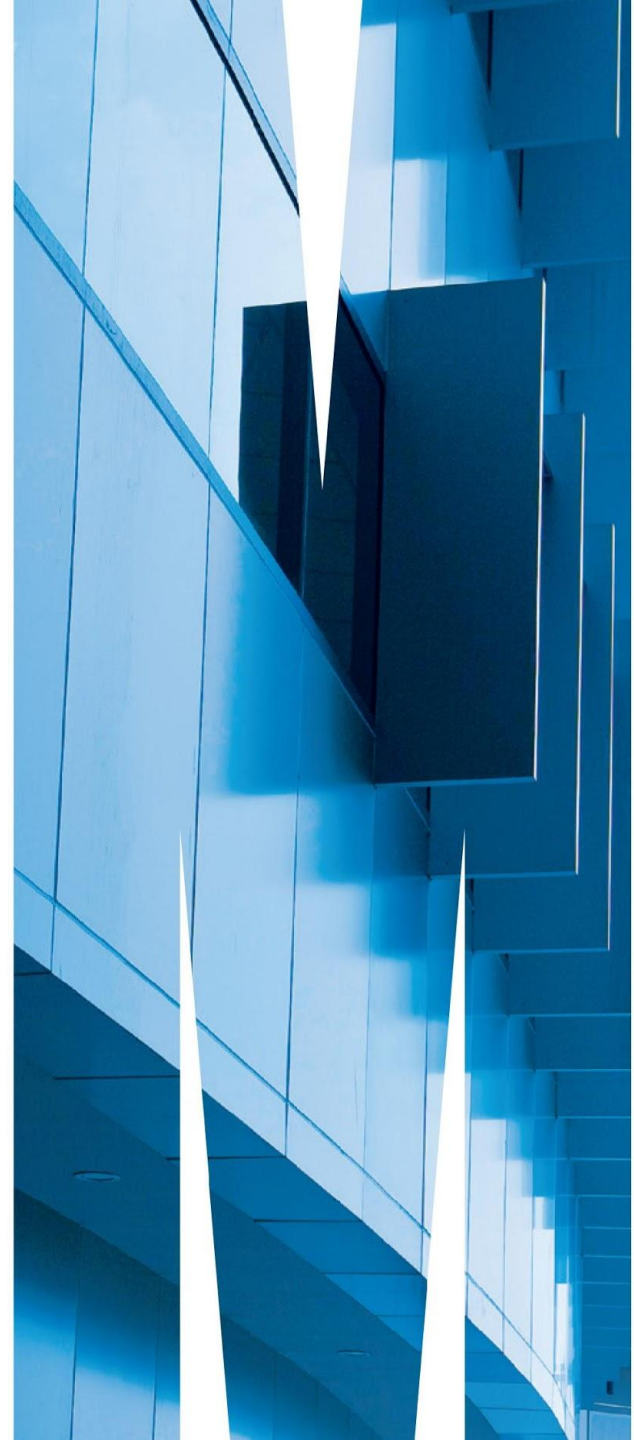

Unit Credit Points

All units are worth 6 credit points.

Students will complete 144 credit points over a period of 3 years (full-time), i.e. 24 units.

Enrolment

Enrolment of maximum 4 units (24 credit points) in each semester for 6 semesters (3 years).

Pre-requisites

A unit that you must have successfully completed, i.e. achieved at least a **PASS** grade, before you can enrol in the higher level unit.

Co-requisite

Co-requisite in relation to a given unit is a designated unit which is studied before or at the same time as the given subject and must be passed before the given subject can be counted towards a degree.

Electives

A unit that you may choose to do outside your core units.

General Studies

- Malaysian students must complete 3 GS units:
 - (i) MPU3113 Ethnic Relations
 - (ii) MPU3123 Islamic and Asian Civilizations
 - (iii) MPU3212 National Language A (Students can be granted exemption for this unit if they have obtained a minimum grade of “C” in SPM Bahasa Melayu, or completed the unit in other institutions)

- International students must complete 2 GS units:
 - (i) MPU3173 Malaysian Studies 3
 - (ii) MPU3143 Communicative Malay 2

- Enrollment in General Studies is through Web Enrolment System (WES).

- Opportunity to study at the Monash campuses (intercampus exchange program) or partner university exchange.
