Students will complete 144 credit points over a period of 3 years (full-time), i.e. 24 units.

## **Enrolment**

Enrolment of maximum 4 units (24 credit points) in each semester for 6 semesters (3 years).



## **Pre-requisites**

A unit that you must have successfully completed, i.e. achieved at least a <u>PASS</u> grade, before you can enrol in the higher level unit.

## **Co-requisite**

Co-requisite in relation to a given unit is a designated unit which is studied before or at the same time as the given subject and must be passed before the given subject can be counted towards a degree.

  - (iii) MPU3212 National Language A (Students can be granted exemption for this unit if they have obtained a minimum grade of "C" in SPM Bahasa Melayu, or completed the unit in other institutions)
- International students must complete 2 GS units:
  - (i) MPU3143 Communicative Malay 2
  - (ii) MPU3193 Philosophy and Current Issues
- Enrollment in General Studies is through <u>Web Enrolment System</u> (WES).
