A total of 144 credit points (24 units) are required with:

- ✓ Part A. **Fundamentals in Communication and Media studies** (24 points)
- ✓ Part B. **Digital Media Core** (48 points)
- ✓ Part C. **Professional Practice** (24 points)
- ✓ Part D. **Free elective study** (48 points) **Important:** Elective units may be chosen from the school or across the University as long as you have the prerequisites and there are no restrictions on admission to the units. The units may be at any level, however, no more than ten units (60 points) at level 1 can be credited to the Bachelor of Digital and Media Studies. Other course requirements:

- ✓ A maximum of 10 units (60 points) from first year level
