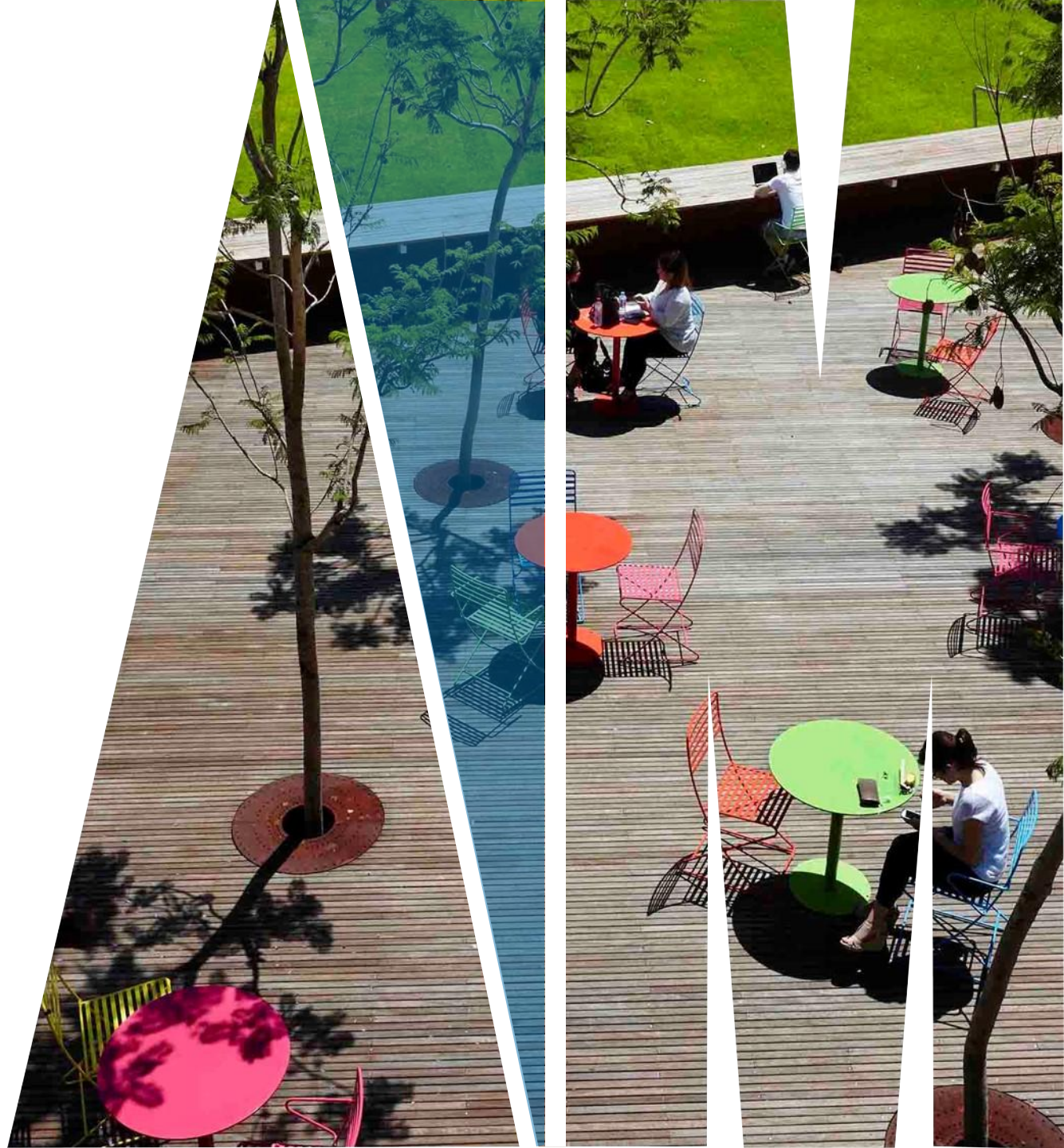

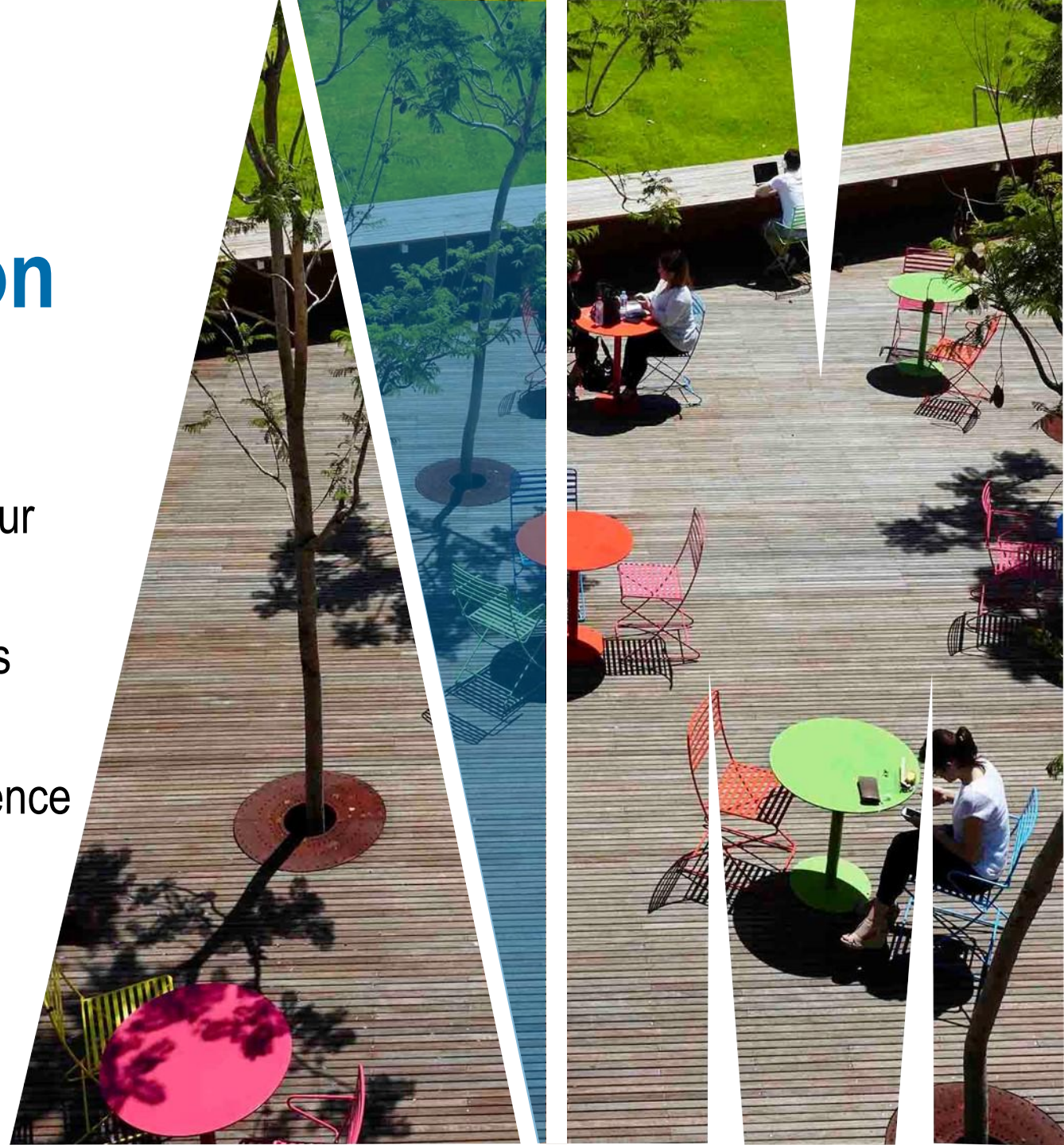

Course Transfer Selection

- You can select three preferences
- You must meet the entry requirements for your course
- You will also need to meet the campus maths requirements
- We will offer you your highest eligible preference

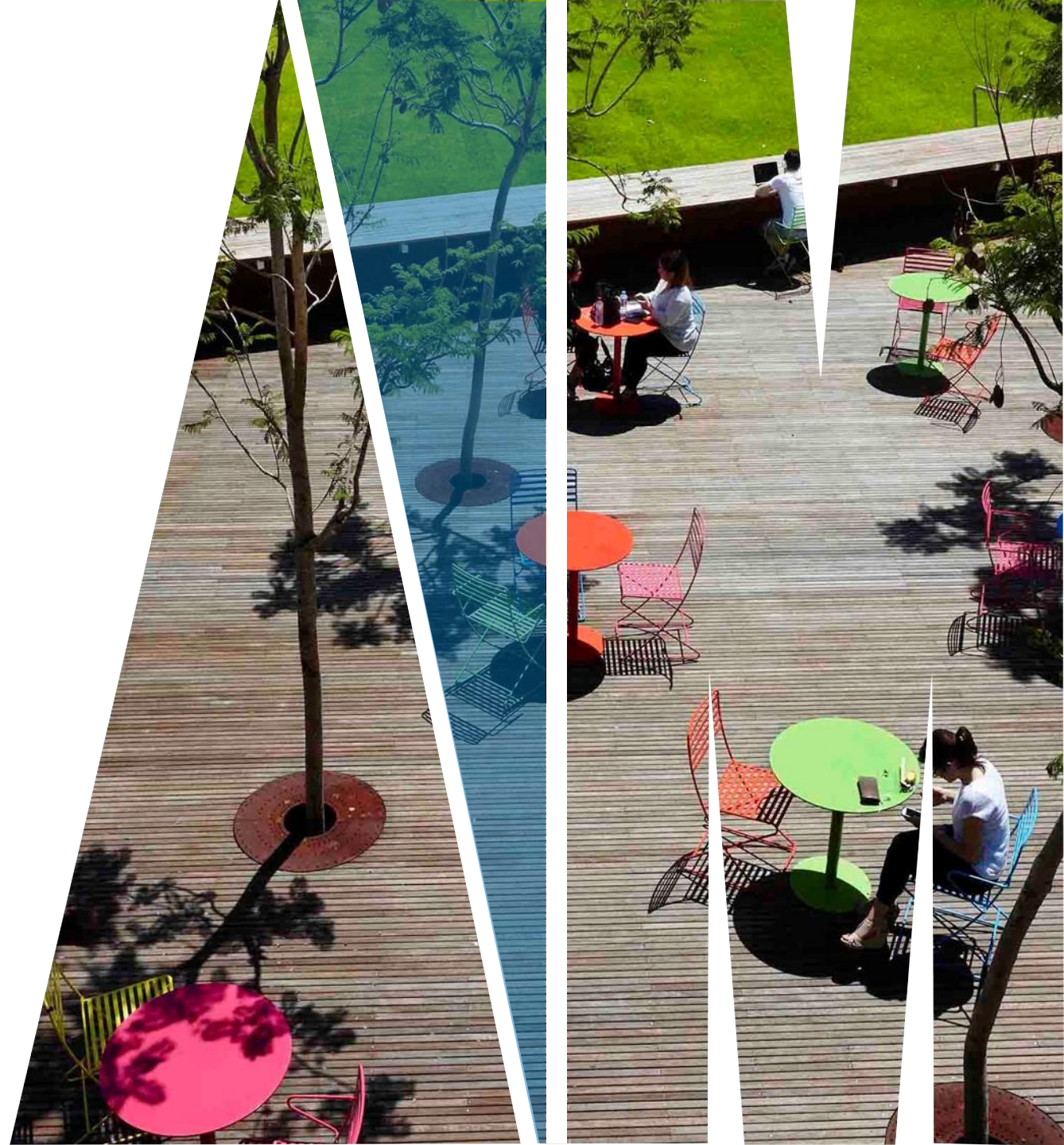

Preferences

- Expand your preference options to include **all campuses**.
- The courses offered at each campus have the **same** entry requirement. This is why it is important **NOT** to put all 3 preferences from 1 campus. Peninsula is the only exception
- The Bachelor of Business & Commerce (B2026) **is not** offered at the Australian campuses.
- **Caulfield** offers 5 single degrees including *The Bachelor of Business (B2000)* and 11 double degrees.
- **Clayton** offers 4 single degrees including *The Bachelor of Commerce (B2001)* and 12 double degrees
- **Peninsula** offers 1 single degree which is *The Bachelor of Business Administration (B2007)* and 2 double degrees.

Academic Requirements

Weighted Average Mark (WAM)

Peninsula – 55 for single degree and 60 for double degrees

Caulfield - 60

Clayton - 70

Maths:

Peninsula: All applicants would have completed the required maths.

Caulfield: VCE units 3&4 of Further Maths (study score 25+), or Maths Methods or Specialist Maths (study score 22+) or equivalent or [ETF2700](#) or [MTH1010](#)

IB: At least 4 in Mathematics SL or 3 in Mathematics HL or 3 in Further Mathematics HL or 4 in Math Studies SL

Clayton: VCE units 3 and 4 of Maths Methods or Specialist Maths (study score 25+) or approved equivalent or [MTH1010](#)

IB: At least 4 in Mathematics SL or 3 in Mathematics HL or 3 in Further Mathematics HL

What credit will I get?

- Monash Business School **does not** pre assess your credit but you will be able to work it out.
- Select the course you would like to transfer into by using the [2024 Handbook](#).
- The 2024 Handbook is available. You can download the course map from the handbook.

example: B2000 – Bachelor of Business – majoring in Economics & Business Strategy

Compare the units you have completed to the units outlined in the handbook.

You can do this by selecting the unit you have done and check if it has a prohibition.

Eg: ECW1101 – Introductory Microeconomics is a prohibition for ECF1100 Microeconomics.

This is a core unit to the degree and the major, and is equivalent to ECW1101. Therefore credit will be granted.

If there are no prohibitions listed against the unit you have completed, you will be offered credit for a business elective at the level you have undertaken, provided it fits into the course structure.

- You will receive confirmation of your credit and your course map when you receive your offer.
- We will offer as much credit as will possibly fit in your new course

We look forward to course advising you during your academic journey at Monash in Australia!

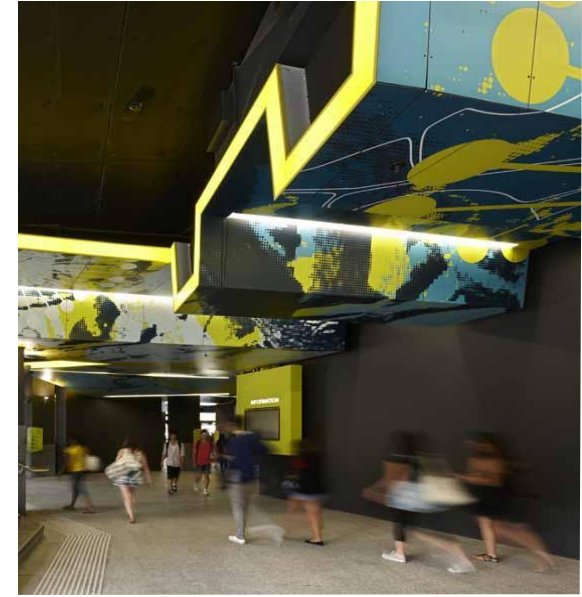
Once you receive your results, offers will go out. ISCA's will be sent. You **must** complete and return the ISCA by the date indicated on the form.

Your course transfer will be processed, along with the credit. You will be notified when this is done.

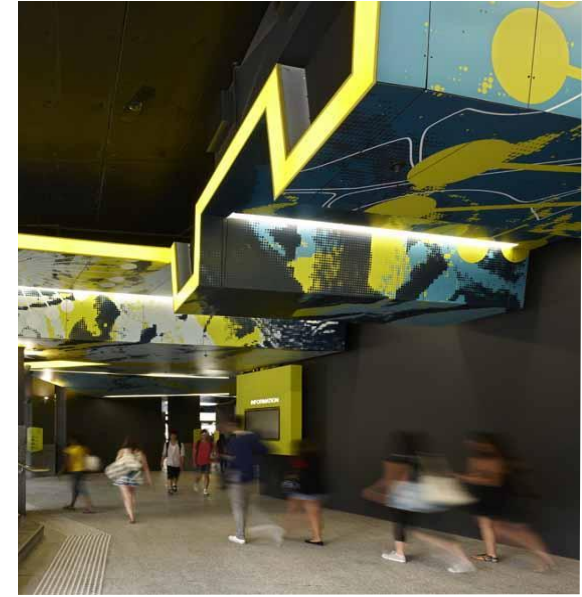
